7 SOURCES OF INFORMATION

The information is collected directly from the data subject. Information is also collected with Google Analytics.

8 DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION TO THIRD PARTIES

The information will not be disclosed to third parties. Some of our providers of external service or software may store information outside the European Union or the European Economic Area.

9 USE OF COOKIES

10 PROTECTION OF THE REGISTER

Merus Power uses a protected Internet connection.

The digital data is protected by a firewall, user codes and passwords.

The data can only be accessed by the persons employed by the Registrar who need the information for performing their work.

11 DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS

The data subject has the right to access the personal data stored by us in the Register. A written and signed request for access should be sent to the person in charge of the Register. This can be done without charge once a year.
